Message from the Chief Executive

Dear residents, families and friends,

We continue to manage COVID at our sites, however I am pleased that our current outbreaks look like they are coming to an end and Aegean Village is now COVID free.

Current COVID outbreaks

Croydon Park

- We have a total of four residents with COVID that are either active or recovering. All other resident COVID cases have resolved.
- Of these four cases, there is one case in St Tabitha and three cases in St Emelia. Both these areas remain COVID zones.
- Residents in St Tabitha and St Emelia will have further COVID screening tomorrow. If we don't identify any new cases it will signify the end of our current COVID outbreak.

St Peters

- We now only have one resident with COVID on the ground floor who is recovering well.
- The ground floor remains a COVID zone.

Keeping residents safe

- Residents in all COVID zones may continue to have visitors, however we do ask that visits take place in the resident's room.
- Full PPE must be worn by anyone entering the room of a resident with COVID.
- A modified lifestyle program is in place for residents in COVID zones.
- We continue to monitor all residents for any COVID like symptoms.

There are currently no COVID cases or restricted areas at Aegean Village, however all visitors must continue to follow the direction of staff.
